We'll do our best to accommodate you if you have special needs, but no promises can be made.

The organizers of this event reserve sole rights to all food & beverage distribution unless approved by the organizers of this event. No beverages may be sold or distributed (for free or otherwise) by any Registered Participants or organizations unless approved by the organizers of this event. If a Registered Participant is found in violation they will be asked to shut down immediately and no refund of registration fees will be given.

Illegally parked vehicles will be towed. Please park your vehicle in the upper parking lot so that customers will be able to park in the lot by the community center.
